THE TOPIC

The focus of BNL's Detector Development and Testing Division is research and development of advanced detectors for nonproliferation, treaty verification and homeland security applications. It also tests and evaluates commercial as well as laboratory prototype radiation detectors at the Radiation Detector Test and Evaluation Center (RADTEC) under funding from the Department of Homeland Security. This presentation will discuss the technologies used by commercial vendors in the detection of radiological material in traffic streams. Some of the difficulties imposed by typical environments in which monitoring must be conducted will be addressed and potential impacts on the flow of commerce and traffic will be reviewed.

OUR SPEAKER

Charles Finfrock has been employed by the Brookhaven National Laboratory for 25 years. He has participated in numerous and varied research endeavors in that time, including the areas of reactor materials science, heat transfer, ultratrace plutonium bioassay, and high energy physics. He is currently a member of the Detector Development and Testing Division in BNL's Nonproliferation and National Security Department. He has recently been named Group Leader of the Radiation Detector Test and Evaluation Center (RADTEC), a facility that provides test and evaluation support to the US Department of Homeland Security's Science and Technology Countermeasures Test Bed.
