

THE TOPIC

This presentation will provide an outline of the dynamics and growing importance of China as a key factor in a company's sourcing, manufacturing and marketing strategy for the coming decade and beyond. First some background information on China as a manufacturing hub and vast market place will be given. Subsequently, various market entry strategies for Western companies will be discussed, including some useful information on socio-demographic, corporate and legal parameters. There will be also a discussion of the key cultural parameters and challenges of doing business in China as a Western company. Lastly, a brief overview of the most relevant questions for executives doing business in China will be given.

OUR SPEAKER

Peter Hanneforth, is President and founder of SpaCom LLC, a global trading firm and supplier of industrial parts and components leveraging a large network of Chinese manufacturing partners. From 1999 through 2003 he held executive positions in Business Development and Marketing for Sulzer Metco, the \$400M surface technology division of the Sulzer Corporation. Prior he worked for 10 years for Corning Incorporated, a \$4B diversified high technology company, where he held various Management positions in Marketing & Sales, Business & Corporate Development and Business Management in both Europe and the United States. During his tenure with multi-national corporations Mr. Hanneforth gained experience in a number of industries in the Americas, Europe and Asia. He has been doing business in China since the early '90s and was spearheading Corning's expansion into China during the mid 90s, ultimately resulting in investments in excess of \$100M. Mr. Hanneforth is also the Vice President and a Board Member of the Thermal Spray Society, an affiliate society of ASM International, and the Chairman of their Programming Committee. He received a graduate degree in Economics and Business Administration from the European Business School in Wiesbaden, Germany and attended the MBA program of the Garvin School of International Management (Thunderbird) in Phoenix, AZ.
